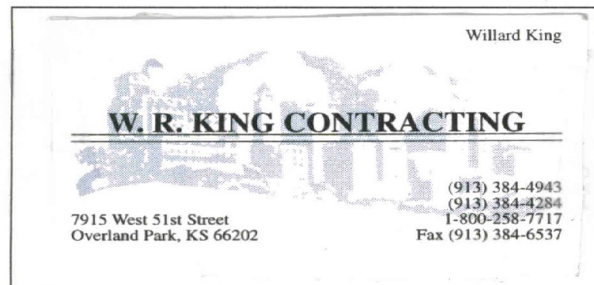
## THOUGHTS AND NOTES

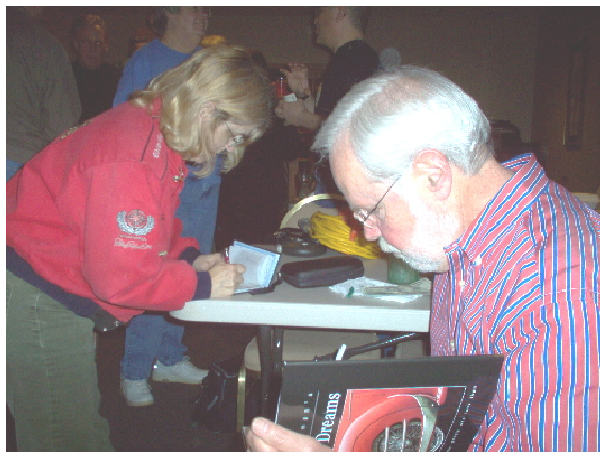
## World of Wheels Exhibit for '07
