From the editor

From time to time I have mentioned having a 1st place trophy for Checkpoint would be nice. Last year the National office made this task more difficult by combining all entries into one judging unit. This means the all regions compete against each other. The websites were also included thus creating the Communication Award.

Each entry is judged for content, relevance, and distribution. Website judging adds utility and function. Nowhere is the cost of producing the newsletter considered. Type of paper, number of pictures, how many pages, are all moot points.

Content is divided into 6 areas with a total of 95 points being available. Under regional news editors are encouraged to include an RE report, minutes of meetings and other relevant region news. The next area is features and includes humor, short stories and member features. Other news includes National news and information, editorials and other information. Another area of judging includes the use of SCCA branding, another is members including member profiles and the last area is officer contact info. Event results and timeliness are the Relevance points and account for 40 more points. 15 points are awarded for distribution including whether a newsletter is available on line and how a member is notified of its availability and if hard copy is available.

A judge may award an additional 10 points for whatever reason. I would guess that might be where appearance might be rewarded. An editor must submit the newsletter to the assigned judges. However the websites are all judged and judging sheets are submitted to the National Office. Although I feel earning a first place award is now more difficult than in previous years, the award itself is also more prestigious. With help from our members I will continue to first, provide a means of communication to the members and by meeting all the criteria of the judging sheet, hopefully bring home the gold!
