RE VIEW WITH DALE SMITH

Hello Everyone,

As I promised in my last article, here is the rest of the history of our Region's Endowment Fund.

In 2000, the Endowment Fund had approximately \$75,000 in it, all in an assortment of CD's. The rates of return on those CD's were below 2% APR. The Board of Directors voted unanimously to diversify a major portion of the Fund into Mutual Funds with the expectation of higher returns. Approximately 2/3 or \$50,000 was invested into Mutual Funds, which became known as the AIM Fund. It was also about this time that \$6200 was also used to buy the current "Truckster" for the Solo Program.

Following the tragedy of September 11, 2001, the Stock Market went into a steep decline. This decline reduced the value of the AIM Fund stocks by about 50%. During the years 2002 thru 2005, the AIM Fund and the remaining CD's were left alone to compound interest in the hopes of recovering some of the losses. No disbursements were received from KVRG during the years 2000 thru 2005. I also believe that one CD of about \$3500 was cashed in to help with cash flow of general expenses.

In January 2006, we received a disbursement from KVRG for the first time since 1999. This \$6000 was placed in a CD and added to the Endowment Fund. The AIM Fund stocks had made some progress at recovery and were slowly gaining value. The Board of Directors began discussions about the future of the Endowment Fund and how it should be managed and invested.

This year, we received another disbursement from KVRG. This \$10,000 was deposited into the Region's general funds. The growth of our operations demanded a larger amount of available funds to help manage our cash flow needs. This has made it much easier to maintain our good credit standing by being able to pay all bills in a prompt fashion. It has also made it possible to continue to make capital investments in equipment for our Solo Program. A refund check was also received from the IRS and that \$3000 was deposited in a CD and added back into the Endowment Fund.

This spring, the Board of Directors determined that our AIM Fund stock should be sold and converted back into insured deposits. There were a number of reasons that this was done, but I won't go there now. It was sold at the highest price it had reached since pre-911 and netted about \$38,500. An additional \$1500 was added to this and CD's were purchased in the amount of \$40,000.

Currently, the value of the Endowment Fund stands at about \$76,500. It is totally invested in a mixture of short and long term CD's, all insured and earning interest at rates above 5%. The current Board of Directors has confirmed its intent to preserve the Endowment Fund at a level of \$75,000, in insured accounts, with the earnings of these accounts being used to help offset the general club expenses. This could change, should circumstances or other ideas arise and the Board of Directors vote unanimously to approve such action. As for me, I really like having our Region in the position to make those choices. It's always easier to find ways to spend money, than how to pay for things when you have none!

Don't forget to vote in the election this month! I'll see you all at our next event!

Ballots for the local election have been mailed. This year we have used our bulk mailing permit which allows us to save more than \$60.00 in postage. Bulk mailing rates are based on number of pieces mailed and they must all weigh the same, so ballots going to members who do not have a spouse as a member will receive 2 sheets of blank paper with their ballot as those members with a member spouse each receive a ballot. This year we have the added ballot for the Solo Advisory Committee. I encourage each of you to vote in this election. The Solo Advisory Committee (SAC) is a committee which will help guide the Solo group including making local rules changes and other decisions which will effect the Solo Group. There are a total of 5 members, 3 were appointed by Board to serve 2 years (term expiring in 2008) and 2 who will be elected now to serve 2 years (term expiring in 2009.) All members can vote for the SAC, but if you are not interested in Solo and do not know the candidates, I can't imagine how you could make a decision.

Scott Peterson, Phyllis Nelson, Chuck Clark and Donna Hill were the members of nominating committee and Mike Farley was the chairman. Many thanks to them for hours spent finding candidates for the 2008 slate of officers. Also many thanks to those members who were willing to let there names be placed on the ballot—you are all winners in my book!


