RE VIEW WITH DALE SMITH

The Rearview Mirror

Hi Everyone,

I know that I have always been taught to look ahead, keep my eyes on the road and to look where you want to go because that is where you are most likely to end up. This advice has served me pretty well while driving, but is also a very good approach to take in general. Choosing a destination and carefully planning a route, staying on course and aiming for your goals are essential to arriving at your planned destination. Always look ahead. Right? Well, sort of.
