It is time to begin thinking about the 2010 racing season. Would you like to be a part in the planning of these events? Three representatives are appointed each year from the KCR The process is pretty simple – all you need to do to represent the Kansas City Region on the Kaw Valley Race Group board is to submit a letter to the KCR BoD stating you would like to be a representative and your qualifications. Of course, you must be a voting member of the KVRG which means you must hold a competitive or a race official license. You must also have served as an officer or director of the Kansas City Region. The board will make the appointments at the November BoD meeting.

Serving on this board requires a little time – there will be a minimum of 7 meetings, one to approve contracts with the track and tentative budget items. There will be meetings to approve sups for each event and to make sure all has been done to create a smoothly operating, event including placement of caterer and trophy orders. These meetings may be held in Baldwin City, Lawrence, or Topeka and usually in the evening. The KVRG board tries to make it easy for all board members.

Dale Smith has indicated he will not seek reappointment so a replacement for him is being sought. Gini Ragan and Alex Clark plan to seek reappointment, they could be replaced by other candidates. Letters are due the BoD by November 20 so that appointments can be made at the November 24 BoD meeting. Kansas Rally Weekend

Rallyists in northeastern Kansas and the Kansas City area will have several opportunities to enjoy drives in the country and to compete with other rallyists in time-speed-distance events as the Kansas Rally Weekend is back! Saturday, November 14, the East to Eason, West to Weston Rally will traverse the paved roads northwestern Missouri. The rally will start at the Legends (106th and Parallel Parkway) and end at the Weston Brewery in Weston, Missouri. While the starting and ending locations for this event will be the same as in 2008, an entirely new route over the paved roads of Platte and Buchanan counties has been devised. This event will be sanctioned by the Kansas City Region of the SCCA.
