

# THE HONDA PERFORMANCE EXPERIENCE

Several weeks ago my son Andrew and I went to a Honda Performance Development open house in Santa Clarita, CA. which is 17 miles (a quick one hour and fifteen minute drive) north of the Burbank airport. The invitation was extended to members of a new program Honda has initiated for grassroots racers.

The facility wasn't easy to find. It's on the top of a hill and not visible from the freeway. The building houses offices for the various Honda racing programs the company supports along with a race engine plant and lab for IRL, Proto Type and Honda Challenge cars. Additionally, there is a very, very sophisticated machine shop and multi dyno engine section there too.

The tour took us through six or seven departments. Cameras were strictly forbidden, except in the area where we had lunch. About 600 people were in attendance which included 65 racers registered in the Honda Racing Line program.

The race group was separated from the other visitors for the shop tour. Without going into all the details I can report that I have never seen a place like this one. As an example, you could truly eat off the floor anywhere in the building. When we went through the dyno section, the production manager explained that the engines are tested for specific race tracks and "examples" are run on the dyno with a transaxle just like they would on the track. There was a video running with a track view with simulated sound representing an engine on the dyno to demonstrate what happened when the dyno tests take place.

The machine shop production tooling is 100 percent robotic as is the parts room where all the parts are stored and picked for engine builds. The day I was there they were making intake manifolds from a solid piece of material. As the CNC machine would finish a designate operation, the robot would take the part to the parts washer, clean and dry it and take it back to the CNC machine for the next operation. Many other parts are made here using the same process and detail.

The lab was especially interesting. There was a crankshaft set up on a measuring instrument for demonstration. The measurements are taken in very small increments around the circumference of all the journals on the crank and then visually displayed on a screen when the operation is complete. Measurements are as finite as two microns. From what I saw on the screen I would assume the journals were near perfectly round. Race engine failures are not an option with Honda!

The tour ended with a wonderful buffet lunch which included a variety of entertainment for the children and an autograph session with Dan Wheldon and Heilo Castroneves, both of whom are very outgoing and fun guys to be with. (I know from experience that it all changes when the green flag comes out on race days.)

## **National Office Notes**

The BOD has selected 9 National races that will serve as qualifiers for the 2010 SCCA Club Racing Super Sweep Award. Additionally, it has been revealed that, while it will continue to serve as a leg of the Super Sweep, the National Championship Runoffs will no longer be counted toward the nationwide point standings. Heartland Park Topeka and the May 1 and 2 race hosted by KVRG is one of the qualifying races for the Super Sweep for 2010. To win the Super Sweep a driver must complete all four tasks in the same class; those tasks being win one of nine key National races, win a divisional class championship, be named class champion In the nationwide points championship and win the SCCA National Championship Runoffs.

The list of "Major" events on the Tire Rack SCCA Solo National Tour will grow from two to three in 2010, with the July 3-4 event in Peru, Ind. Now assigned the title of Northern States Championship. The addition of a third "major" National Tour event will give more Soloists the opportunity to vie for the elusive Solo Triad Award. The criteria for the Solo Triad Award remains the same; a driver must win a National Championship, a Divisional Championship and one of the three "major" National Tour events, all in the same class.


