Another PDX Experience

The night before the PDX School, I dreamed I had been driven off the road by a race driver and went over a cliff. I was told with a smirk "That didn't happen at Topeka, there isn't a cliff. Are you going to chicken out?" I began to wonder why I had opened my big mouth and responded to the challenge of: "Another speeding ticket, you need to take it to the race track."

Saturday morning found seven of us in the tech building with real racers, our instructors. (Obviously I wasn't aware of the dress code and came unprepared with no car names on anything.) We went over the day's schedule and listened to a list of rules about lines and flags. My take was that the guy in the car with you must understand the lines, I didn't. If you see a white flag, wave, any other flag, slow down and ask your instructor. We had to report to the false grid. OK, I did have to ask where and what that was, but wisely I waited until after the meeting.

As we sat on the grid, I had to put the helmet on. Yes I know I need a helmet, but that didn't prepare me for the totally claustrophobic feel of one. Fortunately I had no time to worry about this as we were all waved on to the track. My idea of racing has always been that you just drive as fast as you can all of the time. I had 6 forward gears and I was sure I should use all of them. After a turn or two my instructor starting talking about lines, apexes, keeping your hands in the same position on the wheel, and maybe not using all of those gears. He didn't jump from the car and run after the first session. Perhaps he should have as I had thrown us back and forth in the car, braked wrong for every turn and in general scared myself. He bravely suggested that he might drive a lap or two next session so I would get the basic idea of how you should drive the track.

It worked. What a difference! I actually started to understand some of what he had been saying. Restricting me to two gears, the second track time was wonderful. I actually got so I could go through the first two turns and the 8th one. I finally understood the concept of a line and apex, and he actually told me to accelerate more. This as I was going around a turn at what I was sure was way too fast!

By the third track time, I couldn't wait. What a blast. No wonder people loved this sport. You had to concentrate and think all of the time. How do they do this with 20 other cars on the track, trying to beat them to the corners, I don't know. Did I ever get all of the turns right, no, but at least I knew when I had messed up. Then just as I was getting most of them right some man kept waving a checked flag. My instructor mentioned that did mean I had to stop. Would I do this again? Definitely yes! Thanks David Bennett for not giving up on me.
