RE VIEW WITH GINI RAGAN



Twice in the past year the Region or its officers have been asked about the size of our treasury. I, too, have questioned the size of the treasury. Here are some the facts that I have found.

When you pay your dues to the National Office, depending on whether you hold a regular or family membership, the club receives \$20 or \$25. Our average income from dues in 2009 was about \$730 per month.

The average cost in 2009 to run our club was about \$900 per month. Some of the items included are Checkpoint, registration, hotel and travel expenses for the RE to both the National and Division conventions, the picnic, taxes and professional fees, trophies and longevity pins for members. Each year we try to keep the cost of the awards banquet low and still cover the cost of the event. Occasionally we have to provide funds to cover costs that exceed the income.

At this time the cost to the Region to put on a race is zero dollars. In the past our leaders, along with the Kansas Region, set aside funds to cover those expenses. The KVRG Board has been able to maintain that operating fund and actually distribute disbursements to both regions some years.

The average cost to put on a Solo event in 2009 was \$2419 and the average income was \$2524. There are solo events that show a bigger profit and through the years the club has been able to provide newer equipment including a state of the art timing program (the day of stop watches and pencil and paper are long gone), better radios, and other equipment needed to put on a good event. The solo trailer and truck are both more than 20 years old and need lots of tender loving care.

When the Region began to make a little profit from racing our wise leaders established an endowment fund. This fund is not available for the daily operation of the club, but the interest can be used for that purpose or as the board deems necessary.

Within the past several years there have been times when the checking account was so low that new equipment could not be purchased immediately. As a member of the board I found this was not a pleasant position to be in. I am pleased to report that is not the case today. Through no fault of my own, the KC Region can pay their bills, purchase equipment as needed and still have money in the bank.

Worker/Volunteers and Racers needed for O'Reilly Auto Parts Vintage Grand Prix

August 19-22, 2010

The 2010 Racing Season for Kaw Valley Race Group at Heartland Park Topeka is complete, but that does not mean that racing is complete. For the first time in many years a vintage race is being held at Heartland Park Topeka. Heartland Vintage Racing is the presenter of this event and O'Reilly Auto Parts is the sponsor. If you would like to participate or have more information about this event you can get it at www.HeartlandVintageRacing.com including copies of HVR Rules and Sups and entry forms. The featured marque for this event is the Triumph. Included in the scheduled races are the Kastner Cup and the Victory Lane Vintage Formula Vee Festival Race. A participating vehicle must have been manufactured prior to 1973. Many SCCA race cars are eligible for this event. They must run treaded tires and use wheel widths in accordance with the class they run in.

Although KVRG is not the sanctioning body, the Kansas City Region and Kansas Region have agreed to support this event by encouraging our worker/volunteers to participate. As Gary Kern is going to be the Race Chair along with Bill Rinke of the HVR, I don't think you will see much difference in the operation of this race and the other races at HPT. Most of the Chiefs will also be those you see at all of our races.

Camping for workers will be in the grassy area from the tunnel to turn 9. This area will be secured and only workers will be permitted to park there. This will also be the area for workers to park who are not staying at the track. As always, if you want electricity arrangements must be made with the track. All workers will receive a goody bag that includes a T-Shirt, Worker gatherings will be near turn 8 at the Kent Prather compound. End of the day worker parties will be hosted by the Lawrence All British Car Club. If workers are registered guests at the Ramada Inn, a free cookout is offered Thursday evening. If registering, ask for the Heartland Vintage Race rate (\$69.00). This includes free drink ticket each evening and free hot breakfasts.

Saturday night, workers are invited to the BBQ dinner at the pavilion. Door prizes will be awarded and entertainment will be provided by Soul to Soul from Houston Texas.

Insurance is provided through Heacock Insurance and covers everything on the track and within the paddock.

You will be hearing from Ken and Char Keith, our worker coordinators soon. Please let them know if you will be able to volunteer. If you have any questions, please contact me, Gini Ragan, at 913-909-7097 or timerragan@sbcglobal.net. If I don't have an answer, I'll get it for you.
