Kansas Rally Weekend

Rallyists in northeastern Kansas and the Kansas City area will have several opportunities to enjoy drives in the country and to compete with other rallyists in time-speed-distance events as the Kansas Rally Weekend is back!

Saturday, November 13, the East to Easton Rally traverses the paved roads northeastern Kansas. The rally will start in Lawrence, Kansas at the Grant Township Community Center, 1853 E 1600 Road and end near Ozawkie, Kansas, midway between Lawrence and Topeka. This event will be sanctioned by the Kansas City Region of the SCCA.

Sunday, November 14 will see the "Pavement Ends Again" Rally, the event name signifying the fact that mostly unpaved roads will be used for this tour of Douglas, Jefferson and Leavenworth counties. The start of the event will be at the Grant Township Community Center, north of Lawrence, and end of this event will be at the original "Johnny's" location just north of the bridge in downtown Lawrence, Kansas. We had a lot of dust at this event in 2008 and mud in 2009, which means we're due for a snowy weekend in 2010! This event will be sanctioned by the Kansas Region of the SCCA.

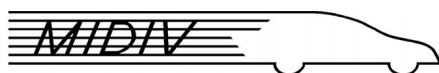

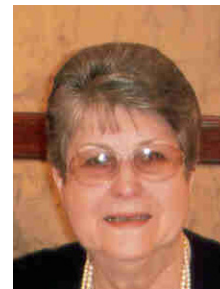
