Dear Mom:

Mike McGinley, Vice President and Executive General Manager of Superior Chevrolet, has been trying for over a year to reunite Dave Parsons, one of their really good customers, and a car he bought new from Van Chevrolet (the name before Superior). The car is a 1965 Corvette Coupe with the 327/375 horsepower fuel injected engine and the 36 gallon gas tank. Dave bought the car new and raced it and won B Production in 1965-1967. The car's current owner is Jay Stahl who lives in Illinois. Jay recently completed a multi-year frame off restoration on the car to restore it to its "showroom new" condition. The car was judged at the



Bloomington Gold Event last summer and has received the "Top Flight" award twice. When Dave ordered the car new he waited for about 4 months to have the car built to his specs, and he's kept every piece of documentation he ever had. It's one of only 741 fuel injected Corvettes built in 1965, and 1 of only 41 "tankers" (36 gallon fuel tank) cars. It's estimated that only 7 cars were built with this configuration and this is one of 4 known remaining examples. Mike said they picked Apr 30th/May 1st weekend because they had the Annual Corvette Show, in conjunction with the Kansas City Corvette Association planned for May 1st and they knew there would be about 1,000 Corvette enthusiasts at the store thru out the day for the show. They parked Dave's car, his trophies, uniform, and pictures right in the middle of the showroom floor. They also had the first ever "Dinner with Reeves Callaway" event Saturday night. Reeves Callaway is the founder of Callaway Cars who currently modifies Chevy Corvettes and Camaros. The Callaway Corvettes produce from 580-652 horsepower and Superior Chevrolet is one of the largest volume Callaway Dealers in the US. They had about 50 Callaway owners for a BBQ, a nice presentation/unveiling of the 552 horsepower Callaway Camaro Convertible and the reuniting of Dave, his crew chief, Garland Wilson and his sponsor, Randy Stafford (former KCR member and race driver) and the current car owner, Jay Stahl. KCR member Willard King stopped by since he is a friend of Dave's. Mike said that Dave was absolutely thrilled with the attention the car got and it's something our customers will talk about for a long time. He also said how cool it was that after 46 years the car, driver, crew chief and sponsor can all get back together and reminisce about racing. He wonders if the future Superior Chevrolet owners will want him and Jeff Kopp to come back for a reunion around 2054??? That sure seems like a long time from now!! A little known fact about Reeves is that he won the SCCA Runoffs in Formula Vee in 1979 (?) but didn't make it through the tech shed. Oops!! Thanks Mike, for a great article.

Ken Keith is working on getting his CPR certification through the Asbury United Methodist Church at 75th & Nall. Ken spent a week in Florida recently taking training to become a Stephen Minister for the church. This is a caring ministry.

Bob Bornkessel was highlighted in the KC Star Magazine in April. Bob can be seen at our local solos driving his 1995 Dodge Neon ACR in F Street Prepared. Bob attended Shawnee Mission North High School some 44 years ago and as a student and All American Athletic, he held 3 national high school track records one of which stood until 2003. In 1967 he ran the 200 meters in a converted time (yards was the measure used at the time) in 21.5 seconds.

In 1968 he set the school's 300 meter intermediate high hurdles record at 36.49. And his time of 49.8 seconds in the 400 meter intermediate hurdles was not just a world record for his age group - it was only .7 seconds behind the overall world record holder, who was 10 years older. In 1968 he competed in the Olympic trials in Lake Tahoe, CA and finished 10th. He earned a full scholarship to the University of Kansas, where he & his teammates won a national track and field championship. After college, Bob simply stopped running. He figured he had jumped over a quarter million hurdles in his lifetime and that was enough! He taught a middle school science class for 4 years then became an expert in industrial safety. He says that he sometimes even goes back to North, just to check to see if his record still stands. And yes, it is still there!

On May 30th there will be a big celebration at the Community Center in Maple Hill, KS when 150 years of marriage will be acknowledged! Ken & Char Keith will celebrate their 40th wedding anniversary, Char's uncle & his wife will celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary and Char's aunt & her husband will celebrate their 60th wedding anniversary! WOW!! Relatives will attend from many states and also from England. Congratulations to all of these great marriages.

SOLO SPOTLIGHT

Formula Junior Program...Where Dreams Begin by Mike and Donna Hill

"Dad, you race...why can't I? When can I race? When do I get to drive? Da-a-a-ad?????"

Sound familiar? Or, do you just want to be able to introduce your child or grandchild to motorsports activities firsthand? Either way, the SCCA solo program may have just what you're looking for with Formula Junior classes, allowing kids ages 5 through 18 a place to compete.

The program is made up of three classes (plus parallel ladies' classes): FJA, FJB and FJC.

FJA (12 to 18-year olds) touts karts that are powered by a Yamaha 100cc engine or Briggs Raptor and World Formula. The karts are only allowed a single rear brake and have weight minimums depending upon the kart. Jordan Hill has driven in this class for three years, bringing home regional and divisional championships each year, Kansas City region rookie driver of the year, and a fourth place trophy his first year at Nationals. Also moving up through the FJA ranks were Larissa Bell and Ethyan Watts, who are now avid solo participants in a Miata and Mustang, respectively.

FJB (8 to 12-year olds) compete in the same kart as the FJA class but must run restrictor plates available from SCCA.

FJA and FJB classes run during a solo event. The FJA/B kids all run in same heat and are usually the first off in the heat. They take one run, return to their grid (separate from the adult cars, for safety) and wait for the adults to take a run. In the past, a junior kart driver ran all of his/her runs consecutively – with no break in between. Several years ago, the format was changed to give the younger drivers some time to let the adrenaline settle a bit, and to get some coaching and encouragement. Parents and young drivers all seem to benefit from this arrangement.

FJC (little tykes ages 5 through 8) karts are considered kiddie karts with Comer 50 /51cc engines at 2 hp. This class is run BEFORE the event and after the drivers' meeting. The FJC kids run all of their runs consecutively. Workers are asked to help these little ones out on course, giving directional signals as needed and always welcomed praise and encouragement. 'Zander Hesscamp, 7, is our inaugural competitor in the class.

The kids (FJA, B and C) all participate in course walks with the Youth Solo Safety Steward, the drivers' meeting, and age-appropriate work assignments. Not only are your kids learning to "drive" and get a feel for motorsports, they're learning responsibility and good sportsmanship, while spending a Sunday with you. So, go ahead. Karts are pretty easy to come by and reasonably priced. A few quick searches online will get your kiddo ready to roll!
