Dear Mom:

Mom just received Alexandra Clark's running update! She has competed in several 5K and 10K events this summer, ending with personal records of 25:40 for the 5K, which is an average of 8 minutes & 17 seconds a mile for 3.1 miles, and 53:11 for the 10K, which is an average of 8 minutes & 30 seconds per mile for 6.2 miles. Her first half marathon will be the Kansas City Marathon/Half Marathon on Saturday, October 15th. As a first attempt at the 13.1 mile distance, she is looking for a 2 hr & 10 minute (9 min, 55 sec/mile) time or lower. Her longest training run has been 12 miles, which she averaged 9 minutes & 40 seconds a mile including water and traffic



stops. She said she was pretty worn out by the end, though! She is already registered for two more half marathon events - one of which she will run with her best friend from grade/high school (Stephanie Bingman Kice) out in Las Vegas on December 4th. The second will be April 2012, the Kansas City Rock the Parkway Half/Marathon. Training requires that she run at least 4 times per week and she is generally running about 20-25 miles per week. Nutrition is a big deal in the last two weeks (which began Sunday, October 2nd). She has reduced her coffee intake, increased her water intake and completely removed fast food and alcohol from her diet. Alex said that many people feel that the 13.1 mile distance is the perfect running distance for competition...guess she will find out soon! Good luck Alex.

Bob Henson retired on September 23rd from the Independence Power & Light Company after 40 years! He plans on first having a retirement party at his home then he will begin "his life of leisure". Bob & Linda live in Lee's Summit, MO with their children, Danielle & Robert.

One was born in Turkey, one in Mexico and one in England (that would be Justin Pritchard who is married to Meredith) and of course we cannot forget Chuck Clark (who is married to Alex) who was born in good ole Kansas City.


