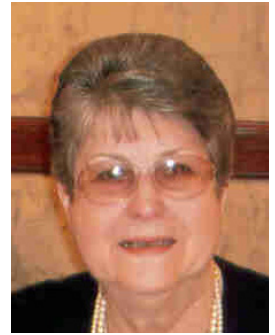

Bill, the owner of Small Fortune Racing came to Pleasant Hill and towed the car and trailer back to MA. Bill will prepare the Cheetah for Jim to compete in solos.

Charlie & Henry Williams, sons of Keith & Cheryl have been competing in the KC Karting Association race series. Charlie, who is a freshman at Blue Valley High School competed in 6 out of the 8 races and finished the season in 3rd place in the TaG Junior Class. Henry recently won the Kid Kart Class Championship for 2011 in Liberty. He is a second grader at Stanley Elementary School and competed in 7 out of the 8 races. Proud grandparents are Charlie & Mom Williams.

Greg Heuer of Raytown & his Moe Dangle Hillbilly Chili team won the People's Choice category for the fifth consecutive year at the 25th annual Lenexa Chili Challenge. This winner is determined by visitors who taste chili samples and donate money to vote for the one they like best. More than 5,000 visitors attended during the weekend and \$3,411.00 was raised for the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation.

Ken Snyder's right knee started to swell up after running recently so he went to the Dr. The x-rays showed some calcium deposits or bone chips floating around the knee joint. Now after surgery, the Dr said he should be good for another 10,000 miles. Ken said he had the same thing done back in 2007 -- guess this means he is averaging 2,500 miles per year?? Ken "Hopalong" Snyder should be off crutches by the November general meeting.

The first weekend of October, Joe & Pauline Tasler traveled to Albuquerque to attend the International Balloon Fiesta. Joe & Pauline lived there for 15 years and had attended the event many times. This year they decided to return & go to the Fiesta for the Saturday & Sunday launches. This is the biggest balloon launch in the world and runs for several days. Usually there are 650 to 700 balloons, and they launch from a huge field that is covered in grass. It is impossible for all 650 to inflate & launch at the same time, so they do the launch of 100 or so, about every 20 minutes. Eventually there is a very large number in the air and with the right weather conditions, many will be flying right over the field. The weather phenomenon is called the "Albuquerque Box" - where in the early morning hours (7:00am), at ground level on the field, there is a slight wind that blows the balloons to the South. Then when they clear the field & can climb up to about 500 feet, the wind direction reverses & blows the balloons back to the North. While Joe & Pauline were there the first day, they set a world record with 345 balloons in the air within 1 hour from 7am to 8am. It was like the entire sky was filled with different color balloons of all different sizes & shapes. Joe said it is a very fun event to attend - but you have to get up very early & be at the Balloon Fiesta field about 5:30am. Spectators (50,000 or more) are allowed to walk onto the field & visit with the pilots as they begin their inflation. Then at 7am, the first balloons begin to rise into the sky, & it goes on and on for 2 more hours until all 650 have lifted off. In the afternoon & evening hours, they have Balloon Glows and Fireworks. This goes on for 9 days.

The Monday after the Kansas Speedway NASCAR race, Rick Hendrick, owner of Hendrick Motorsports visited three dealerships in the Kansas City area. They were the Superior Chevrolet, Superior Toyota & Superior Acura. Mr. Hendrick said he is very proud of the dealerships here. They do a great job and they are like family. He thinks the fans in our dealerships in Kansas City are as strong as they are anywhere in the country. Kansas City Region members involved with the above dealerships are Mike McGinley, Jeff Kopp & Gary Kern.

Kent Edmondson sold his 1993 Toyota MR2 solo car, wheels, tires and trailer to Bill Krekeler of St. Louis, MO. Bill plans on running the car in the St Louis solos. Bill is not a SCCA member yet but hopefully he will be soon.
