

FRESH FACES

Chris Kern took over as our Regional Executive. He wanted to focus on events where we can get to know our current members and get a chance to meet our new ones. With some new events like the Hallo-wine-e Rally and the addition of our members getting to share their short race videos at the monthly general meetings, he has set the stage for more member-focused events in the future.

Neava Ford stepped in as our Assistant RE. She had a busy year representing KCR SCCA as she was the chairperson for the MidDiv Convention, not to mention the many other events she attended.

We welcomed Donna Cross, Brad Smith and Dave Vincent to the Board of Directors. Jeff Bartz, James Cahill and Jeremy Salenius were voted in for Solo Advisory Committee.

We also welcomed the new SCCA National President & CEO Lisa Noble.

OFF TO THE RACES

CLUB

Club Racing had 1 local event this year as KVRG hosted the final round SCCA Mid States Majors Race August 30-31 at Heartland Park in Topeka. While there was only 1 local event, club members travelled across the country as they competed in the Mid-Am Series and Majors events. KCR was well represented in the Mid-Am Series with 10 champions and 4 podium finishers (see results below).

Club Racing hosted the CFR School, better known as Crash and Burn School, at Heartland Park in Topeka on March 15. They also were vital as volunteer workers for the IMSA event at Kansas Speedway on June 7.

SOLO

Solo had 13 events this year – 9 were held at MCC and 6 were weekend double-headers at HPT in conjunction with Kansas Region. They started their season with a Test N Tune April 5 followed by the first race April 6. In addition to the autocross events, they hosted 2 Novice Schools April 12 and July 26 at MCC, a Street Survival School May 31 at MCC, and Tire Rack Starting Line School June 28.

Solo Nationals were held September 2-5 in Lincoln, NE. The Kansas and KCR had 48 racers compete at Nationals with 12 winning trophies (see results below).

The annual **Halloweenie** event was held October 26. The event proceeds were donated to Pedal the Cause out of St. Louis. There were races, costumes, grilled goodies and a silent auction to benefit Pedal he Cause.

KCR Solo adopted a new class – Classic American Muscle. It was based on the National guidelines, even though CAM was not a National class yet. The new class created buzz and interest bringing out new cars to solo events.

RALLYCROSS

Rally Cross had 4 events this year and introduced a new site. Rally Cross kicked off their season on July 19 at Thunder Valley Sand Drags in Grain Valley. Eighteen competitors came out to test out the new venue, which was a flatter, smoother site – making it more street car friendly. They were back at Thunder Valley on August 24 and September 21. Leonard's Farm in Garnett was the location of the final event on November 2.

Rally Cross Nationals were held October 4-5 at the new venue of I-80 Speedway in Greenwood, NE. The KCR group had 4 competitors with 2 of them winning trophies (see results below).

ROAD RALLY

Road Rally had their 2 annual rallies as well as introduced a new social rally this year. The Kansas Winter Rally had to be moved back to March 22 to avoid a winter storm warning. The rally was 100 miles and had 12 cars competing. Lori Goetsch and Martin Courtois took 1st in the Experienced Class. Mark and Judy McCoubrie won the Beginners Class.

On October 25, we introduce the Hallowine-e Rally. The gimmick, no-points rally had 20 participants that were navigating their way to 3 local wineries for wine tasting.

The eighth annual Kansas Rally Weekend was held November 8-9. The East to Easton Rally began Saturday with 17 teams driving the route from Lawrence to Atchison. Jack von Kaenel and Jim Duea won the Expert class, Albert Weaver and Marty Courtois finished first in the Experienced Class, and Peter Monshizadeh and Lindsay Pruitt won the Beginners Class on Saturday. The Kansas River Run Rally began Sunday with 8 returning teams starting in Lawrence and driving a scenic route with unpaved roads. Randy Gregg and Doug Patterson won the Experience Class, David and Aracely Tung won the Beginner's Class. Jack von Kaenel and Jim Duea finished first overall for Expert Class, and Albert Weaver and Marty Courtois were first overall for Experienced Class.

TIE UP THE LACES (loose ends)

Mike and Donna Hill along with Chris and Annie Berg of Topeka were invited to Fontana

Speedway in Ontario, CA in May. They spent their time on the track testing and comparing different tires against Michelin's Premier A/S tires.

Jeff Bartz was selected by SCCA National to be the face of their marketing campaign and was featured in Sportscar Magazine.

We celebrated the 2013 season at the Annual Awards Banquet at the American Legion on January 18, 2014.

The MidDiv Convention was held in Springfield, MO January 31 – February 2. The KCR SCCA was well represented as Neava Ford was the chairperson, Al Hermans and Charlie Clark hosted seminars, and Justin Walker was the MC for the awards banquet.

Our very own Charlie Clark was awarded the 2013 John McGill Award for significant contribution to the Club Racing Program while at the National Convention.

KCR unveiled the new live timing and scoring this summer. Competitors and spectators could keep track of times by going to timing.kcrscca.org.

paper. Shape into wreaths. Add red hots.

JELLO COOKIES

3 oz box jello 2 eggs 1 cup sugar ³/₄ cup shortening-part needs to be butter

Cream above items together.

Stir in:3 cups flour 1 tsp baking powder ½ tsp salt Roll – cut out –back at 375 degrees – 5 to 8 minutes

NO BAKE COOKIES

Second part First part 3 cups instant oats 3 tbsp cocoa 1 cup chopped nuts 2 cups sugar 1 cup coconut ½ cup milk

1 tsp vanilla 1 stick oleo

Bring second part to rolling boil & cook ½ minute. Pour over first part. Mix thoroughly & drop by tsp on wax paper.
