


2015 RallyCross season begins on the Spring Equinox

The 2015 Kansas City Region SCCA RallyCross program begins its second full season of operation on the Spring Equinox at Lenard Holsworth's farm south of Garnett, KS. We have approximately eight acres of pasture in which to play, and if we can start early enough, we'll try for at least ten runs through the day.


