RE Comments



The SCCA National Convention was held in Las Vegas January 16-19. I had the pleasure of representing the KC Region with Tara Young, our new Assist. RE, and her husband James Young. The theme was "One Team, One Experience". It was great to see our fellow SCCA members, some 30-40 year members and some 2-5 year members working together leading seminars teaching attendees best practices in all disciplines of the club. Over the next few months we'll be sharing many of these best practices with the Board and rolling them out at our events.

At the convention Rich Bireta, one of our previous members (he is a Kansas Region member currently) was recognized as a "Member of Excellence". This award is presented to the member that shows the greatest commitment to SCCA activities. Rich was recognized for developing a great new app for Road Rally which uses GPS information to give instantaneous scoring as

checkpoints are reached throughout the Rally and eliminates the need to have timing and scoring teams at the checkpoints. When you see Rich at one of our events be sure to congratulate him, awesome job!

Most members are familiar with the SCCA's Weekend membership, where \$15 gets you a 5 day SCCA membership (which applies as a discount towards your annual membership within the first 60 days). This weekend membership includes you in insurance coverage at the events.



Now we also have a new "Trial " membership, which is also for 5 days and it's FREE and provides the same coverage. This membership is intended for Rally passengers, ride-alongs at Solo or Track events, and worker recruitment. This will be used for people who "don't get behind the wheel" of a car, but participate as a passenger or worker. This Trial membership is a great way to bring out non member friends and family to check out what's going on and share your passion for the cars and the people.

We have a great schedule planned for 2020 for all types of "Fun With Cars". I challenge every Region member to participate in at least one new type of event in 2020, maybe try an Autocross, or a Track Night in America, or a Time Trials event. Maybe get really frisky and run a Rally Cross. When you meet people introduce yourself, find out how long they have been members of the club. Thank them for coming and make sure they feel welcome. Do you know someone that shares your enthusiasm for cars and racing? Bring them to an event this year as a trial member and get them to check it out.

I'd like to thank Paula Diehl for her two years of service as RE, Tim Friest for his two years of service as Assist. RE, and Todd Hesskamp for his two years of service on the Board.

Secretary's Report

• Minutes from the 2018 Annual Meeting were approved

Treasurer's Report

- Finished moving low interest CD's from Bank of the West to Edward Jones
- Set up savings account to move funds specified for Van & Trailer Replacement
- Set up Club Credit Card to streamline paying for expenses. This will help alleviate the burden of having members waiting to be reimbursed for large expenses.
- The IRS informed us we owed taxes for 2016-2018 for 990 Organization Exempt Income Tax since we reported more than \$1,000 in investment income. We appealed under the premise that \$75,000 of the investment money is seed money, but we lost the appeal since we are actually a 501c7 (social club) not a 501c4 as reported on IRS forms. We owed \$93.00 for all 3 tax years.

Membership Report

• 543 members at the time of the Annual Meeting

Solo Report

- 9 events—not counting the MiDiv
- Averaged 105 drivers per event—down slightly from 107 drivers per event in 2018
- Worked on streamlining the check-in process this year

- Entries were down this year
- Thanks to all who entered and worked at events—it's not possible without you
- Brainstorming ideas to increase participation

RallyCross Report

- Battled rain/bad weather all year. Only cancelled 1 event—the rest were rescheduled.
- Average 32 drivers per event—up from 30 drivers per event in 2018
- 103 unique drivers—up from 97 in 2018
- Thanks to the RAC for all of their help

Road Rally Report

- David Williams will be the Road Rally Chair in 2020
- 2020 plans to hold 1-2 TSD rallies and 1 gimmick rally—building the program
- 2021 plans to hold 3-4 TSD rallies with a championship at the end of the year

Web Report

- Awarded \$3,000 from the Track Night in America grant to be used for operation growth through better communication/marketing
- Mike McGinley took over as Webmaster
- The grant helped pay for the website update and monthly maintenance, which runs out in 2020. Seeking members willing to help maintain the website.


