The Story Behind the Award: Tom Holstrom Regional Driver of the Year

The Tom Holstrom Regional Driver of the Year award is given by the region's race group to the most accomplished regional road racing driver in a given year.

Tom Holstrom, aka "Big Tom" to his friends, graduated from the University of Kansas as a chemical engineer. Tom had an exceptional business career and ended up Vice President of Engineering at PBI Gordon Corporation.

In the late 70's Tom was building drag racing engines for a partner's funny car. At the time he was Dick Bergers manager, and Dick talked him into coming out to drive his car, a Corvair of course, in an autocross. Tom liked it so much he decided to build a Corvair on his own. He started with the engine. About the same time Charlie Clark who was already doing both autocross and road racing, also in a Corvair, was in need of an engine for his car and a partnership that lasted almost 35 years was born.

Tom ran the Solo Nationals six times, in 1979 and 1981-85. In '79 he co-drove with Clark Townsend. All the other years he co-drove with Charlie Clark. He trophied once, 1981, 4th in E Modified (Charlie was 2nd).

In Club Racing, Tom was the first recipient in 1990 of the MiDiv Corner Worker's Choice Award, selected by vote of the workers at each race. The award that year was one of Clancy Schmidt's Speedwagon trailers. Tom then auctioned off the trailer so he could donate the proceeds to the Scott Liebler Memorial fund.

Tom raced the Corvair with Charlie in the Mid-Am Championship Regional racing for many years, while Charlie drove the Nationals. He was Mid-Am D Production Champion twice (1981, 1983), GT3 Champion eight times (1986-1993).

One of Tom's most notable racing accomplishments was a stretch where he won 33 consecutive regional races. At the time our Midiv road racing format ran a Regional race on Saturday and then a National race on Sunday, of course all the national drivers also raced on Saturday to get track time for Sunday. To win 33 regional races in a row you had to best not just the other regional drivers but all of the national drivers running as well. Surprisingly, Tom never ran a National race.

Rocky Entriken specifically remembers a race at Hallett, late in the year when they were running the Bass Ackward (clockwise direction). Temps overnight had been below freezing, and by race time were only in the upper 30's. At the start, they were running uphill on the front straight. Tom had not qualified well, but at the green he pulled out to pass several cars, essentially running on the pavement we usually think of as pit-out and then onto the grass under the starter stand. The pit-out had a row of small pylons dividing that pavement from the track. Tom, an experienced autocrosser, had no concern about hitting pylons but they were frozen. He mowed down the entire row, one by one, and each frozen cone literally exploded as he hit them. Six rapid-fire orange explosions – BAM BAM BAM BAM BAM BAM BAM – as he raced up the track. That's how you win 33 races in a row!

His mechanical abilities and his love for cars were passed on to his son, Aaron, the owner of Bob Hindson Racing here in Kansas City.

For all he represented as a racer, a sportsman, and a friend, the Regional Driver of the Year award is named after Tom Holstrom.

Announcing the 2021 KCR SCCA Solo Schedule

The Solo Advisory Council has secured use of the MCC Precision Driving Center for solo events. They are planning a total of 10 events plus a test and tune. The dates are not locked in with a contract yet, but they are 99% sure that the following dates are good.

As usual, we will need event chairs, chiefs, and other additional help to pull this off so anyone who wants to volunteer time and effort will be appreciated. Until directed otherwise by the national office and the Independence Health Department, we will be observing appropriate Covid guidelines which includes masks, distancing, and hand sanitizing. Those who repeatedly refuse to comply will be asked to leave the site. This is the only site we have at this time, and if we lose it because of bad behavior, those responsible will be in the doghouse for a long time. Part of the restrictions for us is limited personnel beyond drivers. Those who usually come with large entourages may need to curtail that until we are allowed larger groups. Also, until the national office allows it, walk up registrations will not be accepted. All registrations will need to be online for the time being.
