The Trials and Tribulations of the SCCA Runoffs

I decided to drive down to Indy to spectate Friday and Saturday to see some of the best racing in the US. There were roughly 896 entries this year, and the place was packed with excitement and anticipation for the races when I arrived Friday morning. I chatted with many KC Region members and some were totally pumped up about their opportunities, and some were frustrated after blowing their good engines in qualifying or getting hit by another driver rendering their car undriveable. I talked to Jim Stevens in the Spec Miata class who qualified 73rd out of 120+, but only the top 72 race so he was packing up.

Everyone got dry racing on Friday, but Saturday was a different story when the rain

started coming down during the Formula Atlantic race and not stopping until just before F Production race. Hans Peter was running 3rd (under a double yellow caution) when the rain started and he came in to switch to rain tires. He rejoined the field in 10th position as the only car on rains (brilliant) - except for some unknown reason, the race was called with 18 minutes remaining. It was a bad call and a tough break for Hans. Charlie Peter, Han's son, finished 2nd in Touring 2 with an excellent drive. It was his 2nd Runoffs and his second 2nd place finish. Great job Charlie.



Cliff Ira won his race in F Production and made a great tire choice for the race. As I was sitting in the stands with one of my crew prior to the race, I was saying "If I was going out right now I'd go out on dry tires, you can see a dry line, it stopped raining for now, and the breeze is drying the track." He responded that the track is still way too wet with standing water and puddles so he'd go out on wets. Clearly the classic dilemma that only the driver can make, betting the National Championship on his

decision. Cliff Ira chose wisely and went out on dry tires and won a very competitive race. He had a huge cheering section in the grandstands, and I'm sure they all celebrated a well earned championship that night.

2021 KCR SCCA Solo Schedule

The Solo Advisory Council has secured use of the MCC Precision Driving Center for solo events. They are planning a total of 10 events plus a test and tune. The dates are not locked in with a contract yet, but they are 99% sure that the following dates are good.

As usual, we will need event chairs, chiefs, and other additional help to pull this off so anyone who wants to volunteer time and effort will be appreciated. Until directed otherwise by the national office and the Independence Health Department, we will be observing appropriate Covid guidelines which includes masks, distancing, and hand sanitizing. Those who repeatedly refuse to comply will be asked to leave the site. This is the only site we have at this time, and if we lose it because of bad behavior, those responsible will be in the doghouse for a long time. Part of the restrictions for us is limited personnel beyond drivers. Those who usually come with large entourages may need to curtail that until we are allowed larger groups. Also, until the national office allows it, walk up registrations will not be accepted. All registrations will need to be online for the time being. As more information becomes available, we will share it via Facebook, the region website, and e-mail blasts. Registration should open soon for the first weekend, stay tuned for more information.
