MiDiv Time Trials at Hastings, NE Drivers and Workers Needed!

Thank you to all the drivers who have already signed up for the MiDiv Time Trials Series 2022 at Motorsport Park Hastings round 4 event. If you haven't signed up, now is the time to do so on this **freshly repaved track!**



This is what everyone has been asking for—a ONE DAY EVENT for Time Trials (TT) and High Performance Driving Experience (HPDE). HPDE is a chance to drive your car on a racetrack in a safe and controlled environment away from the risks present on the street. We will also have coaching available for these sessions, which is a great way to get friends, spouses, significant others, or even your kids to come out and learn how to drive safely on the track.

There will be **FIVE** TT sessions—20 minutes each There will be **FIVE** HPDE sessions—20 minutes each

Vintage or Road Racers are all welcome to drive!

Don't worry about classing if you want to run TT. We will get you taken care of before the event or at the track. You don't need a dyno to run. Transponder rentals are available.

We are short workers for this event so if you are interested in working or know someone who is, let Adam Pessetto or James Cahill know.

The Kansas City Region will offer workers:

- One free Kansas City Solo entry for working the event (\$55.00 value)
- For non-members, we will provide a temporary membership (\$15.00 value)

Camping is allowed Friday and Saturday night, so feel free to show the night before and/or leave Sunday morning! Gates will open at 6pm Friday and Registration will be open Friday 6pm-9pm and Saturday 7:15am-Noon. Tech will be open Friday 7pm-9pm and Saturday 7am-8:30am (it will also be open after that but may take longer as tech individuals may be driving on track).

RV Spots at Motorsport Park Hastings include 20-, 30-, and 50-amp electrical service (no water or sewer). There is potable water available at the track if you need to fill your tank prior to parking. To reserve a spot, send an email to motorsportparkhastings@gmail.com. Be sure to include the overall size of your rig so they can get you in an appropriate spot. Cost is \$50 and is payable at the track with cash, check, or credit card.

Restrooms and showers facilities are onsite and open 24/7. Bagged ice can be purchased on site for \$5 per 10 lb bag. Raceports (covered pit area) are also available to rent for \$75 for the event. Each spot is approximately 12 feet wide by 24 feet long and includes 110V electric and lighting for night time work.
